Pax Hoh Campsite

Pax Hoh has been used by the Derbyshire Guides since 1984, the site is situated near Hulland Ward, and Carsington Water. It is a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre flat field with a large wooden shelter and a toilet/shower block.

This large field lends itself to basic camping, and as a base for visiting the local area and enjoying the water sports available at

The site is also available for day visits and evening activities. As well as camping holidays, it also provides the opportunity, to cook on wood and practice patrol cooking on altar fires and pioneering.

Pax Tor House

Pax Tor has been used by Derbyshire Guiding since 1960, it is situated on a wooded hillside above Darley Dale overlooking the Derwent Valley. We can accommodate 18 x girls, plus a room for leaders (max occupancy 24).

There is plenty to do and much to explore in the area. There are swimming pools and parks in Matlock and Bakewell. The Heights of Abraham via Cable Cars and Gulliver's Kingdom at Matlock Bath. The Red House Stables and Carriage Museum in Darley Dale; Chatsworth House, Farmyard and Adventure Playground; Haddon Hall and the Old House Museum at Bakewell are all within easy reach.

Peak Rail Heritage Railway runs steam trains between Rowsley and Matlock and Crich Tramway Village; the home of the National Tramway Museum is nearby too.
