23rd Jan 24- trial invoices will be available via GO.

6th Feb 24- email reminder to download and check your trial invoice will be sent 19th Feb 24- no more changes will be able to take place

20th Feb 24- official invoices will be available to download and pay either by card of cheque. An email will be sent to let leaders know.

14th March 24- reminder email will be sent to ensure payment is made.

28th March 24- all subscriptions must be paid by this date.
