## **International opportunities- please share with your Guides, Rangers and Young Leaders**

### **Trip 1: Are you ready for the trip of a lifetime? Japan 2027**

In summer 2027, we're taking a small group of up to 12 young people from Girlguiding Derbyshire on a once-in-a-lifetime journey across Japan.

Over two unforgettable weeks, we'll explore some of the most exciting, beautiful and culturally rich places in the world:

Tokyo where we'll find neon lights, anime energy, the world's best Disneyland all in the busiest city on Earth.

Kyoto home to beautiful temples, Japanese traditions and some of Japan's most breathtaking history.

Hiroshima a powerful and important part of world history and heritage.

Nagano National Girl Scout Centre of Japan where we plan to spend a few days volunteering and connecting with Japanese Girl Scouts.

We may also investigate visiting Osaka (if we have time) with its brilliant food, bright lights and legendary fun.

But the programme is not set. Once the group is selected, we'll design the trip itinerary together, choosing the activities and deciding how we want this adventure to be.

Before you apply, here are a few important things to know:

It's hot. July/August in Japan is no joke; humidity and high temperatures every day. So, you'll need to be able to cope with the heat.

It's active. Expect 20k steps a day as we explore multiple cities across Japan. This is a full-on, exciting, on-the-go trip as we'll want to pack in as much as we can.

It's different. Not just the language, but the food, customs and cities too. Tokyo alone has nearly twice the population of London, so you'll need to feel comfortable navigating very busy, very vibrant places.

You'll need to be aged between 16-18 in July and August 2027.

If you're curious, open-minded, up for a challenge and love discovering new places, this might be the adventure you've been waiting for.

### **Trip 2: Cycling the Netherlands 2027**

Are you looking for a challenge in 2027? Girlguiding Derbyshire and Derbyshire Scouts are teaming up to run a week long cycle touring exploration of The Netherlands for Guides, Rangers, Scouts, Explorer Scouts and Young Leaders in Summer 2027.

We aim to cycle around 250km in total, travelling between campsites plus programme days to take part in activities and cultural activities.

The estimated cost is £650. You don't need to be an experienced cyclist, but be prepared to put some training in. We will be holding selection rides for participants in Spring 2026. More info about these dates will be shared through DigiPost and on the leaders Facebook group in the New Year.
