Joint Venture- Update:

Update on the Proposed 2027 Joint Residential Event

Dear Members,

Following the work over the past two years exploring the possibility of a joint residential experience between Derbyshire Scouts and Girlguiding Derbyshire, we want to thank everyone who has supported this initiative so far.

Earlier in this process, a joint committee from both associations came together to develop a clear governance structure and outline key 'go/no go' markers that would guide us through the decision-making journey. This framework has allowed us to carefully and responsibly assess the feasibility of the proposed event.

We were pleased that significant progress was made — a dedicated group visited and evaluated several potential venues, resulting in two strong contenders: one in Staffordshire and the other in Nottinghamshire. These locations offered promising options for what could have been a memorable joint residential experience in the summer of 2027.

However, at this next critical stage, we were required to fill three essential leadership roles to move forward confidently: two lead organisers (one from each associations) and a finance team leader, ideally individuals with experience in overseeing largescale events.

Despite positive engagement and the interest shown by our community, we have only been able to appoint two of the three required roles by the deadline. As a result, and in line with the agreed governance markers, we must now take the difficult decision not to proceed with planning the event for 2027.

While this news is disappointing, it reflects our commitment to ensuring that any large-scale event we undertake is done so with the right structures, leadership, and support in place from the very beginning.

Although we won't be progressing at this time, the spirit of collaboration and ambition behind this idea will continue to inspire future possibilities.

Thank you once again for your continued support and understanding.
