Leaving your meeting place safely. - How to take your girls out for an outdoor activity safely.

Getting Away with GAW from book to reality. - A closer look at the Going Away with scheme and how to complete essential modules to enable you to take girls away on residential.

What type of leader are you? - Discover your leadership styles.

How to lead the programme - This session for Young Leaders to help them to be an active part in delivering the programme in their unit.

How to use YL's in running the programme - This session is for leaders to help them support the Young Leaders in their unit to deliver the programme in their unit.

Running a unit meeting inclusively - How to start, end, plan, adapt, evaluate and administer inclusively - relevant for all sections

Five minute fillers - Need some quick games, activities and fillers to keep everyone occupied whilst waiting for others to finish, then this is for you! - All sections

Programme through STEM - using Stem activities to give the chance to experiment, build and explore. STEM activities lets girls work as a team, think holistically, communicate better and have fun for Guides & Rangers

Games with a purpose - Have fun learning some games to be used in the unit.
