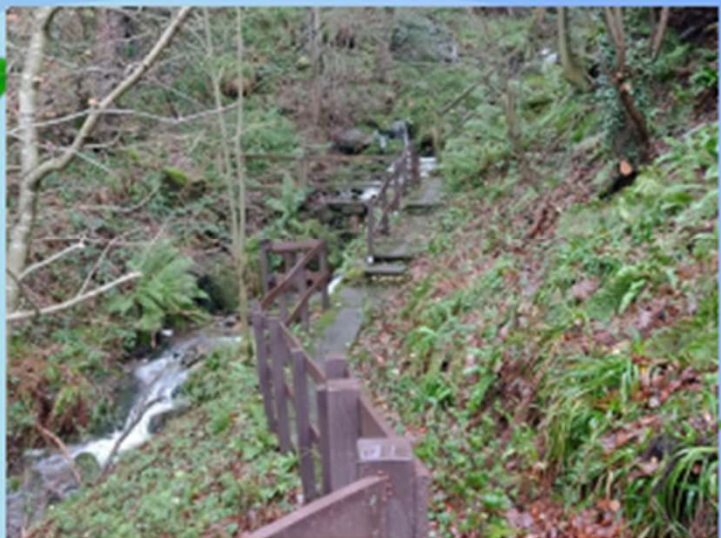

Make it your next adventure!

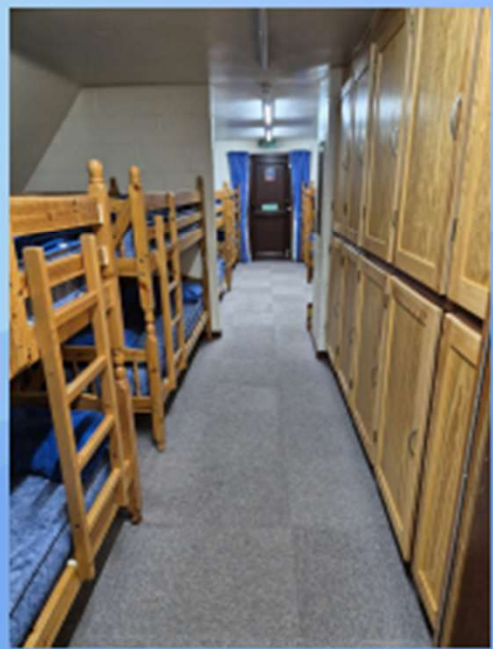
