

Band of the Household Cavalry Outreach Opportunity

The Band of the Household Cavalry is a British Army band based in Windsor. It is the country's largest symphonic wind band and is the only band to play mounted on horseback in the UK.

They can visit units/events to give presentations about who they are and what they do, including bringing along pieces of uniform to show the girls and teach them elements of drill and marching.

They can also invite groups that are interested to either watch them perform in a Changing of the Guard ceremony in Windsor Castle, followed by a tour of their stables in Windsor to meet some of the horses, or to go along to attend an open rehearsal held at Norden Farm Centre for the Arts, based in Maidenhead.
