

#### Glenbrook Activity Centre.

Some of you may be aware that Girlguiding Derbyshire lease Glenbrook from Girlguiding UK. For some time now the Derbyshire trustees have been reviewing the best way to support a large and busy activity centre like Glenbrook within our county, and even for a county as big as Derbyshire this can be a challenge.

The situation over the last year has escalated this review and the ongoing discussion with Girlguiding UK and as a result of these activities, the Derbyshire trustees have now reached a proposed solution with Girlguiding UK to seek a mutual surrender of the lease, allowing Glenbrook to come back under the direction and management of Girlguiding UK from 1st April 2021.

From the perspective of the users of Glenbrook, little will change in practice, so if you already have bookings in place these will remain unaffected by this change and the brilliant staff; Alison and Sam, will support the smooth transition back to Girlguiding UK and will also move to join the national Activity Centre staff team.

Of course, we all want to get back to residential activities as soon as possible and once we are allowed to do that, it is the intention to open the site as soon as feasibly possible and this move will ensure that Glenbrook will have the benefit of the wider Girlguiding UK team's support to do so.
